A standard Hong Kong Hedge Manager Background Check includes:

Licensing Check – Any registrations will be checked with the Hong Kong Securities & Futures Commission (SFC), with details reported. Also reported will be any disciplinary issues. A regulated activities search will be conducted for fund name to determine status.

Blacklist and Sanctions Lists – Research will be *conducted in Hong Kong* to determine whether or not the subject party has been involved in an investigation, launched by The Securities and Futures Commission (SFC);

HedgeCheck will also run the manager's name through a series of Hong Kong, UK, US and international databases that cover disciplinary actions for securities and trading violations, arbitration cases and awards. The SFC, US federal licensing violations and charges, OFAC and "trading with the enemy" violations, FBI, Scotland Yard, Serious Fraud Office, Companies House exclusions, as well as dozens of other specialty databases that cover wanted terrorists, money laundering figures and more from around the world. Often, these searches are referred to as "Know Your Customer" or "Know Your Vendor" searches. HedgeCheck and its primary



vendors update these databases routinely to use the “freshest” information possible. Many proprietary databases are also checked. These services actively seek out information about hedge managers and offshore financial centers and can be a tremendous resource. On more than a few occasions, this basic search can help avoid terrible regulatory and public relations problems.

Courts Searches –

Searches in Hong Kong will be conducted for cases linked to the subject for High Court Actions, District Court Actions, either as Plaintiff or Defendant. Directories will be searched for links to bankruptcies or winding up proceedings.

Additionally, databases will be searched for various precedent setting Hong Kong civil cases, Hong Kong Public Law Reports and Hong Kong Unreported Judgments which mention the subject.

Officers & Directors – HedgeCheck will list the name, domicile and status of corporations, LLC’s LP’s and more which might be linked to the subject. Note that these searches are incredibly inclusive, but not comprehensive as the use of nominee’s and official filing companies is common. None the less, this is a very good search and can reveal hidden or undisclosed business relationships and ventures, and even past employment that was not otherwise volunteered. It is also helpful when researching the subject for media articles to know what companies that may have been affiliated with in the past.

SEC & EDGAR Searches

These massive databases are searched for references to the subject company or individual, giving insight to the names of companies which with the subject might have had past or current dealings as well as size of deals and shareholdings registered to the subject. HedgeCheck will note in the report a summation of the types of filings located. We will not simply forward a massive “data dump” to our clients and expect them to sort it all out. Often, the individual is listed only once as a person of record in a filing that is hundreds of pages long. That information will be abstracted into the final report. We screen the filings for you, we don’t just “dump” hundreds of pages for our client’s to have to pour through.



Media & Press Articles

Experienced HedgeCheck investigators will draw on multiple Hong Kong, UK, US and international media databases for references to your subject (English language only). We will provide a written summary of the types of coverage the subject received.

- Are the mentions in self-promoting press releases or releases touting a certain investment?
- Are references to the subject in serious business and news publications which tend to repeatedly seek comment from the subject – possibly indicating that he is a serious, respected source?
- Do media reports confirm claims made by the subject on his resume or other background source?
- Did media reports reveal significant problems, like past fraud, regulatory actions or sanctions?
- Was the subject involved with a questionable company or partners?

The types of mentions that the subject receives are important – even if they are not negative. But obviously – any item of a serious or potentially negative nature will receive primary coverage, and appropriate back-up materials will be provided to document any such allegations or reports. As with SEC research, HedgeCheck WILL NOT simply forward a huge “data dump” download. Our experienced researchers will seek to sort out the information that is useful to our clients.
